

Continuous Shot Assignment

If you are using one of our D3000 camera's you will need to turn on continuous mode. Click the menu button and then under Shooting menu, select Release Mode, Continuous. For best results USE A TRIPOD!

Depending on the motion you may need to adjust shutter speed by turning the dial to action or sports

Once you have your source pictures the rest of the work can be done in Photoshop. Using the appropriate selection tools extract 3 images of your subject and neatly place them on the background.
